Remote forensics is a secure architecture upon which full digital forensics, imaging and analysis can be conducted, without pulling any of the data back across the network. It allows our experts to be 'on site' anywhere in the world at the press of a button, performing all the usual forensic tasks of imaging, analysis and reporting.

This unique approach comprises remote controlled forensic hardware 'PODs' which sit in a customer's locations and are brought into play when an incident occurs. Nothing is physically installed on your system: your POD is accessed via a Forensic Incident Management Service, which is a unique, sophisticated and secure web-based application. At the first sign of a digital incident, the suspect media is placed into the POD by technical support and is then securely accessed by a remote forensic specialist. They image the data and analyse it immediately.

Remote forensics doesn't touch your networks. There is no need to access the corporate network and no software is installed on any other computers.
